What This Means For You

FTC Complaint Data (Last 30 Days)

Legal Calling Hours

Under FTC rules, telemarketers cannot call you before 8:00 AM or after 9:00 PM in your local time zone (PDT). Any calls outside these hours are a violation you can report at reportfraud.ftc.gov.

Do-Not-Call Registration Package

RingWage has researched every Do-Not-Call registry that applies to your number and verified the current enrollment process for each one. Below is your personalized registration checklist.

Federal Do-Not-Call Registry (FTC)

The National Do-Not-Call Registry is managed by the Federal Trade Commission. Registration is free and does not expire. The FTC requires you to complete the final step yourself for identity verification.

Your Checklist

- Go to donotcall.gov and click "Register Your Phone"
- Enter your phone number: **(310) 902-4120**
- Enter your email address for confirmation
- Click the confirmation link in the verification email within 72 hours

What Happens Next

Once confirmed, telemarketers are legally required to stop calling your number within 31 days. After that period, any telemarketing call to your number is a federal violation and you can file a complaint at donotcall.gov.

Double Protection

We recommend registering on BOTH the federal and California lists for maximum coverage. State lists often cover additional caller types that the federal list does not.

Your Legal Protections

Once registered on the Do-Not-Call list, you are protected under federal law. However, certain call types are legally exempt:

| Exempt Caller Type | Why It's Exempt |
|---------------------------------|---|
| Political organizations | First Amendment protections for political speech and campaign calls |
| Charities | Nonprofits may call directly; hired telemarketers must still honor the list |
| Surveys and polls | Legitimate research calls with no sales component are exempt |
| Existing business relationships | Companies you've transacted with in the last 18 months may call |
| Informational calls | Appointment reminders, fraud alerts, delivery notifications, etc. |

Protection Recommendations

RingWage recommends the following steps to fully protect (310) 902-4120 from privacy exposure, spam calls, and unwanted telemarketing:

- Opt out of each data broker listed above — start with the "Easy" ones
- Register at donotcall.gov following the steps in this report
- Register on the California state DNC list at the URL above
- Enable ActiveArmor on your AT&T Wireless account
- Install a call-blocking app (Nomorobo, Hiya, or RoboKiller)
- URGENT: Your number appeared in a data breach — change passwords on accounts linked to this number
- Never answer calls from unknown numbers — let them go to voicemail
- Do not press any buttons or say "yes" during a suspected spam call
- Consider using a secondary number for online forms and signups
- Review app permissions — revoke phone number access from unused apps
- Report spam calls to the FTC at reportfraud.ftc.gov
- Any telemarketing call before 8am or after 9pm PDT is illegal — report it immediately
